- \$150 allowance towards frames, lenses, and/or contact lenses, combined, per contract year¹

- 15% discount (per contract year) for contact lenses and initial fitting
- \$0 for eyeglass frames and lenses for dependents under age 19, one pair per 12 months

Exclusions:

- Industrial and athletic safety frames
- Eyeglass lenses and contact lenses with no refractive value
- Sunglasses without corrective lenses, unless medically necessary
- Eye exercises
- Non-corrective contact lenses
- Contact lens services other than the initial fitting and purchase of contact lenses as provided in this section
- Replacement of lost, broken, or damaged lenses, frames, and contact lenses
- Plano lenses
- Lens adornment, such as engraving, faceting, or jewellery
- Low-vision devices
- Non-prescription products, such as eyeglass holders, eyeglass cases, and repair kits
- Orthoptic (eye training) therapy
- Any eye surgery solely for the purpose of correcting refractive defects of the eye, such as nearsightedness (myopia), farsightedness (hyperopia), and astigmatism (for example, radial keratotomy, photorefractive keratectomy, and similar procedures)
